

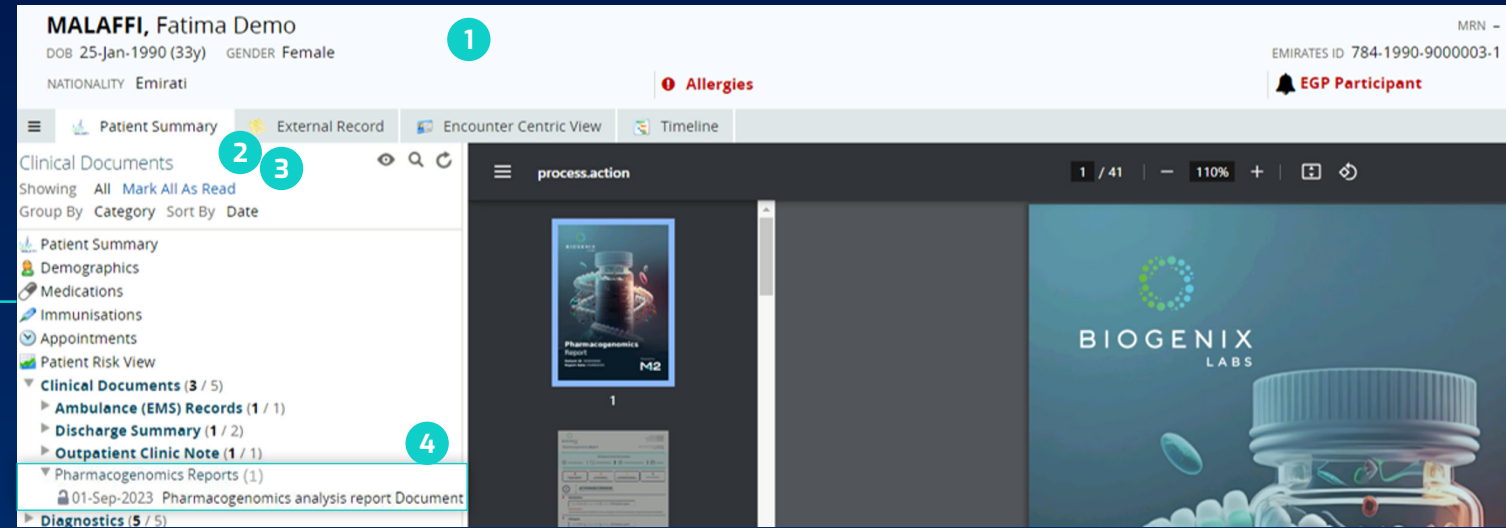
Malaffi Provider Portal Quick Reference Guide - Pharmacogenomics Reports

Pharmacogenomics reports play a vital role in medication classification by providing insights into how an individuals' genetic makeup influences their response to specific medications.

This personalised approach to medication classification helps providers make informed decisions about drug selection and dosing, optimising therapeutic outcomes while minimising adverse effects.

Medication classification in Pharmacogenomics Reports involves categorising drugs based on an individuals' genetic makeup. Patients are classified as Ultrarapid, Poor, Intermediate and Normal Metabolisers based on genetic variants affecting drug metabolism. This classification informs dosing adjustments.

Currently the Report is only available to Level 1 users following 'Break the Privacy Seal'.



1 Access Provider Portal

Access the Patient record by selecting the Malaffi icon in your EMR.

2 Breaking the Privacy Seal

The Pharmacogenomics report is a sensitive report that requires breaking the seal to view it. If the *Break Privacy Seal* is active, the patient could have a Pharmacogenomics report available. Select *Break Privacy Seal* to see if the Pharmacogenomics option is available.
